# • What is Torrens Health Hospital in the Home?

A Torrens Health Hospital in the Home is a new service providing specialist care for patients who may benefit from receiving treatment at home rather than in hospital.

# • Who is eligible?

A Anyone who has Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) or Overseas Visitor Health Cover (OVHC) with Allianz Care Australia.

The patient must also be:

- Clinically stable
- · Living in suitable accommodation to receive care
- · Able to access additional support if required e.g. by a relative or carer
- · Agreeable to the proposed Hospital in the Home treatment plan

# • What treatments are available through Torrens Health Hospital in the Home?

- A Treatments available to patients include:
  - Intravenous (IV) infusions including antibiotics for cellulitis, kidney, or urinary tract infections
  - Complex wound dressings
  - · Pain management (IV and subcutaneous injections only)
  - Insulin Dependent Care for Patients

# • Where is the service available?

A Torrens Health Hospital in the Home is available across capital cities and in some regional locations.

# Q Does the patient have to start treatment in a hospital first?

A No, you can refer directly for Torrens Health Hospital in the Home care if the patient meets eligibility requirements.
